The Convention shall enter into force 12 months after the date on which 15 states have become Parties to it in accordance with Article IV; 2.

The International Convention on Maritime Search and Rescue (SAR) was adopted by an international conference held in Hamburg, Germany, in April 1979. As its title implies, this Convention is designed to improve existing arrangements and provide a framework for carrying out search and rescue operations following accidents at sea.
